Who can apply?

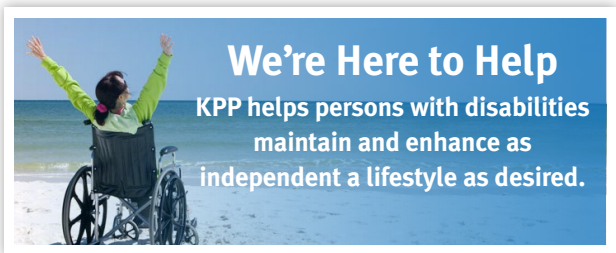
Support Services are offered to people over the age of 16
